**The Traffic and Road Safety Act (Speed of Motor Vehicle)
(Temporary Maximum Speed Limited) Order, 2011.**

(Under sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, Cap. 361).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Minister responsible for transport by sections 135 and 175 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, Cap. 361, this Order is made this 12th day of April, 2011.

1. Title.

This Order may be cited as the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed of Motor Vehicle) (Temporary Maximum Speed Limited) Order, 2011.

2. Temporary maximum speed limit.

A temporary maximum speed limit is prescribed up to a limit of 180km per hour for drivers of motor vehicles, who compete in the Southern Motor Club Challenge Rally to be held on 6th - 8th May, 2011.

3. Exemption.

Subject to paragraph 2, a person who drives a motor vehicle and competes in the Southern Motor Club Challenge Rally on 6th - 8th May, 2011, in Masaka and Rakai districts, organised by the Federation of Motor Sports Club of Uganda (FMU), in conjunction with the Southern Motor Club, is exempted from the provisions of section 120 of the Traffic and Road Safety Act, and the Traffic and Road Safety (Speed Limits) Regulations, S.I No. 33 of 2004 for the duration of the rally.
